

Product Safety Recall

TOY "GIGGLING"

Socrates Enterprises Pty Ltd has sold toys that do not comply with the applicable mandatory consumer product safety standard. The toy 'Giggling' was available for purchase at shops trading under the name "Socrates for Curious Minds" across Australia from January 2006 until March 2007. A total of 612 toys were sold.

The product concerned is a wooden head with a rattle attached and carrying a retail value of approximately \$19.95. The product came in a white box with a picture of the product on the front and the words "Giggling", "Made in Taiwan", the trademark "Child Friend" and the barcode 4716841202171. Below is a picture of the toy



The toy "Giggling" does not comply with the applicable mandatory consumer product safety standard for toys for children 36 months and under as the toy dummy and ring attached by a string to the toy may pose a choking hazard. If you have purchased a toy "Giggling", do not allow children aged 36 months and under to use the product
